


- Color page 80 while listening to Bach's *Toccata and Fugue in D Minor* (**7**).

Part 1: Introduction

Teacher | Children

- 1. Play *Hello Song* (🔊 1) to indicate the start of music class.
- 1. Stand.



- 2. Demonstrate the movements in the lyrics: wave hello, clap hands, stamp feet, turn around, touch the ground.
- 3. Play *Hello Song* (), do motions and encourage children to sing and move.
- 4. Say: "You did very well. Please sit down. Which of our music friends are mentioned in the *Hello Song?*" [Beethoven Bear and Mozart Mouse]
 - Show the plush animals, Mozart Mouse and Beethoven Bear, to the children.
 - Ask: "Who remembers the kinds of sounds that Mozart Mouse likes?" [high sounds]
 - Ask: "What kinds of sounds does Beethoven Bear like?" [low sounds]

- 2. Imitate teacher's movements.
- 3. Sing and move as indicated in the music.
- 4. Sit, watch, listen, and answer questions.
